1. **Title**

The Club shall be called Handy Cross Indoor Bowls Club.

2. Objectives

The objective of the Club shall be to promote the indoor game of bowls.

3. Membership

- a. Membership of Handy Cross Indoor Bowls Club is open to all regardless of race, creed, religion or gender.
- b. The Committee shall have absolute discretion to control the number of members admitted to the Club, subject only to clause 13 of this Constitution, and to accept or refuse individual applications for membership or renewal of membership.
- c. The minimum age of a member shall be at the discretion of the Club Committee. Regarding prospective members under 14 years of age the behaviour and action of that member on the green will be taken into account before granting membership.

4. Subscriptions

- a. The subscription is to be determined annually at the General Meeting.
- Membership subscriptions shall be paid in advance. It must be the responsibility of the joining member to obtain a receipt for the payment before he or she becomes an officially registered member and is eligible to partake in Club activities or National Competitions.
- c. The Membership year of the Club shall be the period commencing on 1st October and ending 30th September in the following year. Subscriptions not paid by the 30th September shall be deemed to have lapsed membership.

5. Rights, Privileges and Liabilities of Membership

- a. The rights, privileges and liabilities of each member shall be personal to him/herself and shall not in any circumstances be transferable. The member shall comply with the Constitution and Rules of the Club and shall not act in any way detrimental or prejudicial to the interest of the Club or its members.
- b. A list of members' names, addresses, emails and telephone numbers will be will be stored on a computer at the club's control and will be subject to current legislation on the keeping of such records.
- c. Members are requested to inform the office of any change to this personal information within 7 days of the change being made.
- 6. Conduct of Members

A member who disregards any regulation of the Club or is guilty of conduct, which, in the opinion of the Committee, renders him or her unfit for membership, shall be liable to expulsion. Such a member shall be furnished by the Committee with a statement in writing of the charge against him or her and shall be afforded an opportunity of answering them either verbally or in writing. If within a reasonable time no explanation is given, or if in the opinion of not less than a quorum of the members of the Committee at a meeting called for that purpose, the explanation is unsatisfactory, the member may be forthwith expelled.

7. Financial Year

The financial year shall commence on the 1st April and end on the 31st March.

8. Election of Committee and Officers

a. The A.G.M will elect the following Club officers and committee.

- b. The Club Committee quorum shall be five members.
- c. All nominations for election duly proposed and seconded must be notified to the Secretary at least 21 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.
- d. Sub-Committees to be appointed to deal with ladies' and men's matches, competitions,
- e. The Committee has the right to co-opt members if necessary.

9. Audit of Accounts

An independent audit of the accounts will be arranged by the Committee.

10. Functions of the Committee

The functions of the Committee shall be:-

- a. To meet at least six times a year.
- b. To receive reports from the Club Secretary, Treasurer and other Officers.
- c. To consider and deal with matters of current administration and matters affecting the interests of the Club, whether raised by Members, Local Authorities or otherwise.
- d. To deal with all questions of emergency.
- e. To submit a report on the Club's activities to the Annual General Meeting.

11. Annual Report and Statement of Accounts

The annual report and duly audited statement of accounts shall be submitted to the Annual General Meeting. The date of the A.G.M. will be posted up on the Club notice board 28days prior to the Annual General Meeting. The agenda shall be posted on the Club notice board 14 days prior to the A.G.M. Such notices shall be deemed to be sufficient for Club Members.

12. Alteration of Rules

These rules shall not be altered or rescinded, except with the consent of the majority of the members present and voting at the Annual General Meeting or at a special meeting convened for the purpose. All amendments must be received in writing by the Club Secretary at least 21 days prior to the meeting. Such notice must be proposed by a member and seconded by two other members.

13. Membership Limitations

The number of members shall be determined by the committee. When the maximum number is attained a waiting-list shall be operated. However, residents of the Wycombe District Council area will not be denied membership because of this restriction.

14. Dress on the Green

a. For all organised Club matches, leagues, competitions and roll-ups – grey clothing below the waist is to be worn which may include trousers, skirts, knee length shorts and cropped trousers with any visible socks ankle length. Leggings or blue denim fabric is not permitted. Footwear must be approved bowls shoes.

Above the waist predominantly white or Handy Cross club shirt is to be worn, and if desired a jumper/cardigan (either sleeved or sleeveless) in white or light grey can be worn. A Club jacket or similar dark blue top may also be worn. For organised roll-ups and League matches officially recognised branded bowls shirts may be worn.

- b. At non-organised roll-ups only, casual dress is permitted. For specific matches advanced notice will be given that appropriate white clothing below the waist with all white or HCIBC club shirts above the waist.
- c. Under no circumstances are members permitted to wear blue denim jeans on the green.
- d. Smooth soled Bowling shoes must be worn at all times on the green, and to protect the carpet from damage by dirt brought in from outside, members must not enter the bowls complex wearing their bowling shoes.
- e. Failure to comply with the above may result in action being taken under Section 6.

15. Health and Safety

a. Under no circumstances may food or drink be consumed on the green.

- b. Bags, outdoor clothing and shoes should be left in the changing rooms.
- c. Any member preparing to play on the green must carry their woods along the walkways to their allocated rink. No woods may be bowled across the green to any rink.
- d. No animals are allowed on the club's premises except for guide dogs, hearing dogs or assistance dogs for people with other disabilities.

16. Indemnity

The members of the Committee and any Sub-Committee of the Club shall be indemnified, firstly out of the assets of the Club and in the event that the assets of the Club are insufficient then by the Members, against all costs claims and demands made against them, and incurred by them in the proper discharge of their duties. The amount payable by each member shall be in proportion to the subscription paid or payable by them in the accounting year in which the indemnity falls to be paid.

17. Notice of motion for the Annual General Meeting

Any notice of motion for the A.G.M. must be made, in writing, to the Secretary at least 21 days prior to the meeting. Such notice must be proposed by a member and seconded by two other members.

The above rules include all the changes approved by the members at annual AGMs

League Rules 2025-2026

- 1. All players must be current members of Handy Cross Indoor Bowls Club.
- 2. All matches to commence exactly at the appointed time.
- 3. Each match shall be played over <u>16 ends</u> or to the finish of the end in play when the first bell rings. The end shall be deemed to have commenced when the jack has been cast before the bell rings. If the end has not been completed when the second bell rings one more wood may be delivered, if necessary, to equalise the number of woods delivered by each team. The shots shall then be counted.
- 4. The winning lead of each end shall cast the jack for the next end. If the jack is of illegal length the opposing skip shall place the jack and have control of the mat.
- 5. In all games any team making a 'no end' shall forfeit two shots and the end shall count as one of the <u>16 ends</u>.
- 6. PAIRS

When a team fails to appear or only one player is available 5 minutes after the due starting time they shall forfeit the game, 2 points and 9 - 0 shots to the opponents.

- 7. TRIPLES
 - a. When a team falls to appear or only one player is available 5 minutes after the due starting time they shall forfeit the game, 2 points and 9 - 0 shots to the opponents.
 - b. If only 2 players of a triple are available each shall play 4 woods (all from the same set) and be penalised by giving 5 shots to their opponents which must be entered on the scoreboard at the start of the match. Their opponents (the triple) shall each play 3 woods. The team with 9 woods will always go first but the winners of the previous end will position the mat and roll the jack.
 - c. A third player may join the game before the commencement of the fourth end. In this event the 5 shot penalty will be reduced to 3 shots and the scoreboard adjusted accordingly.
- 8. RINKS
 - a. When a team fails to appear or only two players are available 5 minutes after the due starting time they shall forfeit the game. 2 points and 9 0 shots to their opponents.
 - b. If only 3 players of a rink are available Nos. 1 & 2 shall each play 3 woods, (all from the same set) and be penalised by giving 5 shots to their opponents which must be entered on the scoreboard at the start of the match.
 - c. A fourth player may join the game before the commencement of the fourth end. In this event the 5 shot penalty will be reduced to 3 shots and the scoreboard adjusted accordingly.

- Matches affected by extenuating circumstances will be postponed if there is less than 90 minutes playing time remaining in the session. Matches will be rescheduled, if possible, at the discretion of the office management.
- 10. All games must be played on the dates shown in the handbook.

Only in exceptional circumstances may any game be re-arranged, The penalty to be imposed on the defaulting team for failing to abide by this rule will be the forfeiture of 2 points and a shots score of 9-0 to their opponents.

- 11. <u>No player</u> may play for more than <u>one team</u> in any league.
- 12. No substitutes will be allowed once a game has started.
- 13. Each player must be registered by their name, initial and membership number. All players must be registered before the start of their first game. Any registered player who has not played more than three times for a team in the current season may, at his/her request, be transferred to another team with the consent of the original team's captain.
- 14. Responsibilities of team skips are as follows:
 - a. He/she must be present in the Bowls Hall at least 5 minutes before the game is due to start.
 - b. The home team skip must complete the score card supplied by the club Legibly and Accurately. He/she must enter the names of all players of both teams. The scorecard must be carried by the home skip at all times so that all shots for and against both teams can be correctly entered as each end is completed.
 - c. The away skip shall ensure that the electronic scoreboard shows the correct score throughout the game.
 - d. At the end of the game the home team skip must check the score card with the opposing skip and both must sign to say that it is correct.
 - e. Failure to complete the official score card Legibly and Accurately may result in the disqualification of one or both teams.
 - f. Once checked and signed the official score card must be posted in the letter box outside the club office before the home team skip leaves the club.
- 15. As time is of the utmost importance in all our league matches all players are required to observe the following :
 - a. The head is not visited by the lead or two in triples, or the lead, two and three in rinks until they have all delivered their required amount of woods.
 - b. Both skips then leave the head together and do not visit the head again unless there is a serious dispute needing the attention of the skips. The Committee expects the spirit of this rule to be followed and any individual, or team, who persistently fails to observe it will be liable to penalties as adjudicated by the Disputes Committee.

- c. Members waiting to play must keep clear of the end of the rinks and must not place their bowls on any rink or edge until it has been vacated by the previous players.
- 16. Any points not covered by these rules shall be subject to a ruling by the Disputes Committee.
- 17. All other rules to be played under E.I.B.A. rules of the game.

- Competitions will be played in accordance with current laws of the sport published by the world Indoor Bowls Council. Domestic variations as detailed hereunder will apply. Only registered members of the Club will be eligible to compete in the competitions. Members who belong to another Indoor Bowls Club will not be eligible to play in the Handy Cross I.B.C. competitions if they enter the competitions of the other Club. Failure to observe this rule will result in the offending player/team being disqualified from the competition.
- 2. All composition bowls must bear a legible stamp for 1985 or later.
- 3. Entrance fees for competitions will be fixed by the Committee and paid for before the first game is played. All players must be named when registered on entry.
- 4. Rinks will be drawn when both players for a singles match or a representative of each team are present.
- 5. An end will not be started after 1 hour and 55 minutes from the commencement time of the session or the bell, except games resulting in a draw of both shots and ends. If the jack has been delivered the end will be deemed to have commenced and will be finished save that if a 'no end' results the game will be over and the jack will not be re-delivered.
- 6. Games to be decided as follows: -

SINGLES - The first player to score 21 shots or the score after two hours **PAIRS – TRIPLES – FOURS – AUSTRALIAN PAIRS**. The highest score after a two hour session wins.

If the game is tied: -

- a. If the shots are equal the team having won most ends will be declared the winner.
- b. If equality still exists an extra end shall be played.
- c. If the extra end is made a 'No end' by a player, the end and game Is automatically awarded to the opponent.
- d. Except In the Semi-finals and Finals there shall be no trial ends
- 7. 101 Competitions. Singles will be played with 4 woods. Pairs will be played with 2 woods, (any combination of players). Scoring 1st wood 4 points, 2nd wood 3 points, 3rd wood 2 points, 4th wood 1 point. Tied woods score equal points. A player making a no end gives 10 points away. The wood nearest the jack takes the mat. The winner/s is/are the player/s reaching 101 first when the end has been completed. If the game is not completed in 2 hours then the winner/s is/are the player/s with the highest score at the end of the 2 hour session.
- 8. **SETS SINGLES –** Two Sets of Nine ends each will be played, a coin toss to decide who starts the first set. Loser of the toss starts the second set. If the

game is drawn at one set each, there will be a best of three ends tie break. One shot to decide each end. Toss to see who starts the first end of the tie break. The loser of the toss starts the second end, if the game is still tied, the winner of a final toss decides who starts the final end.

- TWO WOODS SINGLES WITH YARD STICK 21 ends will be played. Only woods within the yard stick to count at each end. All ends to count regardless of whether there is a score or not.
- In all Semi-finals and Finals there will be no time limit on play and there will be trial ends. In the Pairs and the Fours Competitions the game will be played over 18 ends and the Triples will be over 16 ends. In the event of a tie, ends to be counted. If still a tie, an extra end must be played.
- 11. All "No ends" taking place within the 1 hour 55 minutes time limit will be replayed except as provided in Rules 5 and 6c.
- 12. The Jack shall be rolled in all competitions.

13. SUBSTITUTES

Only one substitute will be allowed, by permission of the Competition Secretary In Pairs, Triples and Fours. In the Mixed Fours (2 men and 2 ladies) and Mixed Triples one substitute of each sex will be allowed. Substitutes may be allowed in the Semi-Finals or Finals if agreed by the Disputes Committee. In the Pairs Triples and Fours prior to the first game registered- players may only transfer to another team with the permission of the Competition Secretary. After the first game (Pairs, Triples and Fours) the named players shall constitute the playing team. Substitutes must not have already played in the competition in which he/she has been invited to substitute.

- 14. All competitions shall be played on fixed dates except when mutually agreed by both teams and the Competition Secretary. They may be played in advance of the fixed date at any time if rink space is available otherwise the original fixed date must stand. The Competition Secretary may alter a competition date if the rink is required for a National Competition, or a player in the Singles or Pairs is required to play in a Handy Cross Club or Bucks County Representative Match or Semi/Finals of a National Competitions. The new date will be by mutual agreement, where possible, but the Competition Secretary's agreement is necessary and his decision shall be final.
- 15. Singles. The first named player in each pairing must appoint a marker who must be a member of the Club. No game shall be played without a marker. The first named player shall forfeit the game if they do not supply a marker.
- Any entrant not on the green ready to play their competition by the second siren (or 5 minutes after the session time commencement) will forfeit the game.
- Competition scorecards recording all players' names, signed by both skips, must be placed in Bowls Office letterbox. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OF THE DEFAULTING TEAM'S.

- 18. The Disputes Committee will handle matters not covered by these rules. Their decision shall be final and binding. A dispute must be submitted in writing to the Competition Secretary who will refer it to the Disputes Committee.
- 19. Preventing displacement by a bowl from an adjoining rink
 - a. A bowl at rest on the rink, if in danger of being moved by a bowl from an adjoining rink, may be lifted by any player at the head to allow the neutral bowl to pass, and then be replaced, provided such action would not influence the outcome of the head so moved.
 - b. Alternatively, any player at the head may stop a bowl from an adjoining rink which is in danger of colliding with a bowl in the head, however, he shall stop a bowl which appears likely to collide with the jack. If the bowl that has been stopped was in its original course it shall be replayed, provided it was delivered on a bias which would have resulted in it re-entering its own rink.
 - c. The marker shall stop any bowl from an adjoining rink which is likely to displace the jack or any bowl at rest on the rink on which the marker is officiating.
